Hacienda South and Hacienda West are joining together to purchase and install several AEDs (Automated External Defibrillators) throughout both neighborhoods. AEDs are LIFE SAVING DEVICES that re-establish heart rhythms during cardiac arrests.

Over 200 neighborhoods within The Villages have already purchased AEDs, and as a result LIVES have been saved. The Villages Public Safety Department has completed a survey of our neighborhood and would like to discuss putting these AED devices in our neighborhoods. Following their presentation, they will answer any and all questions.

While EMTs reach you in 4-6 minutes, neighbor rescuers respond, on average, in 90 seconds! TIME is critical to save your life.
